HANCHER CLOCK

14TH AND MAIN STREET

A project of Wheeling Heritage, this 1889 clock was restored and put in front of the Wheeling Visitors Center in 1998. Take a selfie with the historic timepiece, then stop into the Visitors Center to plan your time in Wheeling.



CENTRE MARKET

2200 MARKET STREET

The Centre Wheeling Market, built in 1853, is a historic public market older than the state of West Virginia! Take a walk around the market, find your new favorite shop or restaurant, and take a selfie to mark the occasion!



HERITAGE PORT

14TH AND WATER STREET

This waterfront park reconnects Wheeling with the Ohio River. Head to the port and walk along Heritage Trail for plenty of picturesque selfie opportunities, such as one with the Suspension Bridge in the background.



OGLEBAY MANSION

1330 OGLEBAY DRIVE

The 1846 Oglebay Institute Mansion Museum is the former summer home of millionaire philanthropist Earl W. Oglebay. Walk inside, step into the past, and explore Wheeling's history. Then, snap a selfie with Mr. Oglebay's portrait.




