**Wheeling Heritage Media Presents ‘Wheeling Haunts’**

WHEELING, W.Va. – Oct. 7, 2022 – Have you had a spooky encounter in a Wheeling building? The Wheeling Heritage Media team has set out to tell the stories of Wheeling’s haunted homes with their new podcast ‘Wheeling Haunts’. Every Monday in October, the podcast will detail a historic Wheeling home that has had supernatural encounters.

This podcast will feature four homes around Wheeling that have a connection to the history of the Wheeling. Each episode will include a brief history of the home or area the home is located in by a local historian, along with a ghost story from the owner or resident of the property. The final episode will allow listeners to tell their own stories and encounters.
