#### "WHO IS WHEELING HERITAGE?"

As the birthplace of West Virginia and an early industrial hub along the Ohio River, Wheeling holds a unique place in American history. Congress designated Wheeling as one of just 62 National Heritage Areas, which allows us to tell these rich cultural stories while preserving its natural and historic resources.

In 2016, Reinvent Wheeling, the city's Main Street program, merged with Wheeling Heritage. As a Main Street West Virginia Community, Wheeling Heritage expanded its role in business development, city planning, and public art. Since 1994, we have leveraged funding and expertise to help shape Wheeling's redevelopment.













# 30 YEAR ANNIVERSARY HIGHLIGHTS

Celebrating three decades of impact and growth, this marks a year of reflection.

- Friend of Heritage Breakfast: Honored Jeanne Finstein for her contributions to historic preservation.
- Power of Partnership Panel: Engaged with key community stakeholders to drive new collaborative efforts in developing Wheeling.
- Show of Hands 10-Year Anniversary: Reached a grand total of <u>\$143,864</u> in funding support for local businesses, growth and retention.
- Wheeling Island Memorial Flood Wall:
   Continued preservation efforts, including the restoration of the flood marks, to honor this historic landmark.
- Wheeling Artisan Center Renovation: Made significant progress on vital renovations to enhance this community space, welcoming several new tenants and hosting successful art exhibitions that showcase local talent.
- Arthur I. Boreman Memorial: Contributed to the preservation of Arthur I. Boreman's legacy with the dedication of a statue at WV Independence Hall honoring West Virginia's first governor.
- Walter Reuther Memorial: Installed a new placard honoring the labor leader at Wheeling Heritage Port with UAW support.
- Wheeling Gateway Visitors & Heritage Center:
   Collaborated with partners to shape the future of
   Wheeling's historic districts, including the Tipping
   Point initiative, funded by the Wheeling Heritage
   Foundation, which focuses on driving the city's
   growth.

This year has been filled with accomplishments that honor Wheeling's past while driving forward its future.

**OUR MISSION** is to be a catalyst for the revitalization of Wheeling.

Preserving historic properties through the National Park Service's Paul Bruhn Grant, the **Wheeling Historic Revitalization Subgrant Program** fuels projects like **The SMART Centre** and **Waterfront Hall**. In addition, Wheeling Heritage supports local revitalization efforts such as the restoration of **Mt. Wood Cemetery**, neighborhood surveys in **North and South Wheeling**, and the creation of new historic districts, including **Dimmeydale**.

#### **Small Business Development:**

Supporting entrepreneurs through programs like **Show of Hands** and **CO.STARTERS**, while hosting bi-annual events like **Handmade Holiday** and promoting **Small Business Week** to help local businesses grow and connect with the community.

#### **Arts & Culture:**

Nurturing community pride through public art installations, artist workshops, and exhibitions at the **Artisan Center Gallery**, including events like **Hip Hop: A Black Tie Affair** and **Juneteenth** celebrations, which provide artists with platforms for growth, cultural expression, and retail opportunities.

#### **Grants & Investment:**

Investing in historic renovations and public spaces like the **Capitol Theatre**, while facilitating partnerships that drive community growth, including the **West Liberty University's 48-Hour Film Festival**, **Ohio County Schools' History of Wheeling**, the **SMART Center**, **Warwood Farmers Market**, and other local initiatives and events.
